SBC Ride Leader Cue Card

- Welcome riders to the Seattle Bicycle Club and introduce yourself.
- State name of ride and level.
- Define level in terms of speed and regroup policy and state what riders can expect from leader.
- Remind riders to be helpful to and responsible for each other.
- Make certain that everyone has signed the waiver, received a map/ cue sheet, if applicable, and is wearing a helmet.
- Remind everyone to check their bicycles for mechanical problems, to lock their cars and not leave valuables out.

- **Review** the following:
 - ✓ the route

- ✓ any known hazards
- ✓ after ride activities
- ✓ weather considerations

- Offer these safety reminders:
 - ✓ Don't ride beyond your ability.
 - ✓ Obey all traffic laws, stop at all stop signs.
 - ✓ Ride no more than 2 abreast, single file in heavy traffic.
 - ✓ Ride as far to the right as practical.
 - ✓ Communicate verbally, i.e. "car back", "on your left", "stopping", etc.
 - Communicate visually, i.e. hand signals for turning, stopping, road hazards, etc.
- Make announcement of other rides, events etc.
